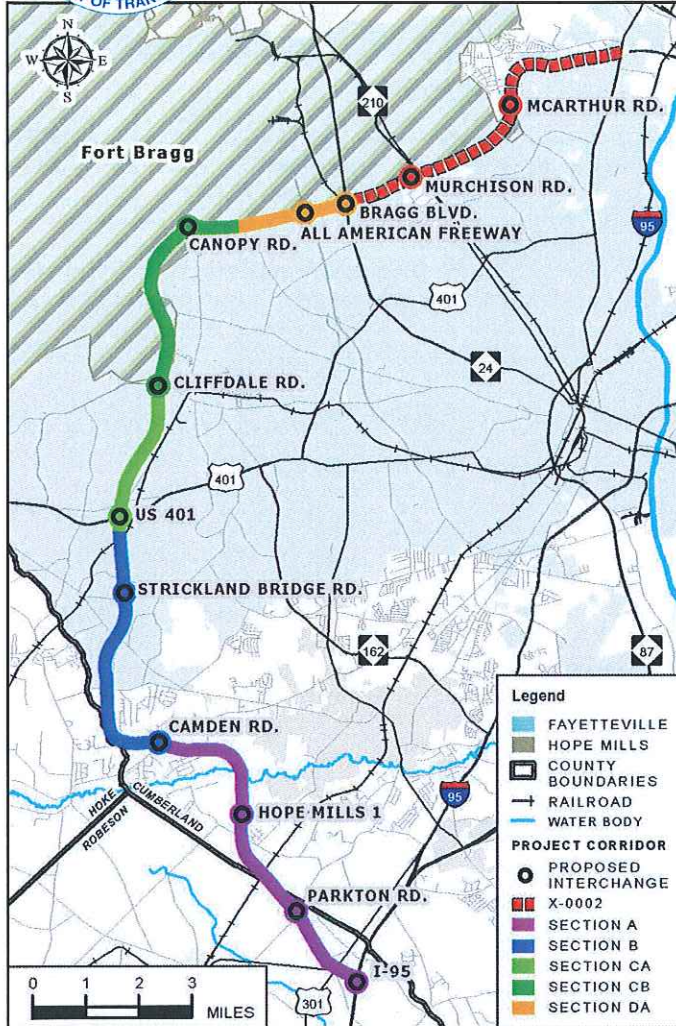




# Fayetteville Outer Loop

TIP Project No. U-2519



## Project Description:

The proposed Fayetteville Outer Loop will create a route around the City of Fayetteville, providing access to I-95 north and south of the city. The Outer Loop will:

- Reduce the volume of traffic on portions of the local street network;
- Connect major radial routes in the south, west and north portions of Fayetteville;
- Provide a direct link between Fort Bragg and I-95;
- Improve military access in the event of an emergency deployment;
- Create additional route options for approximately 25,000 daily commuting soldiers and civilian workers;
- Provide an additional crossing of the Cape Fear River.

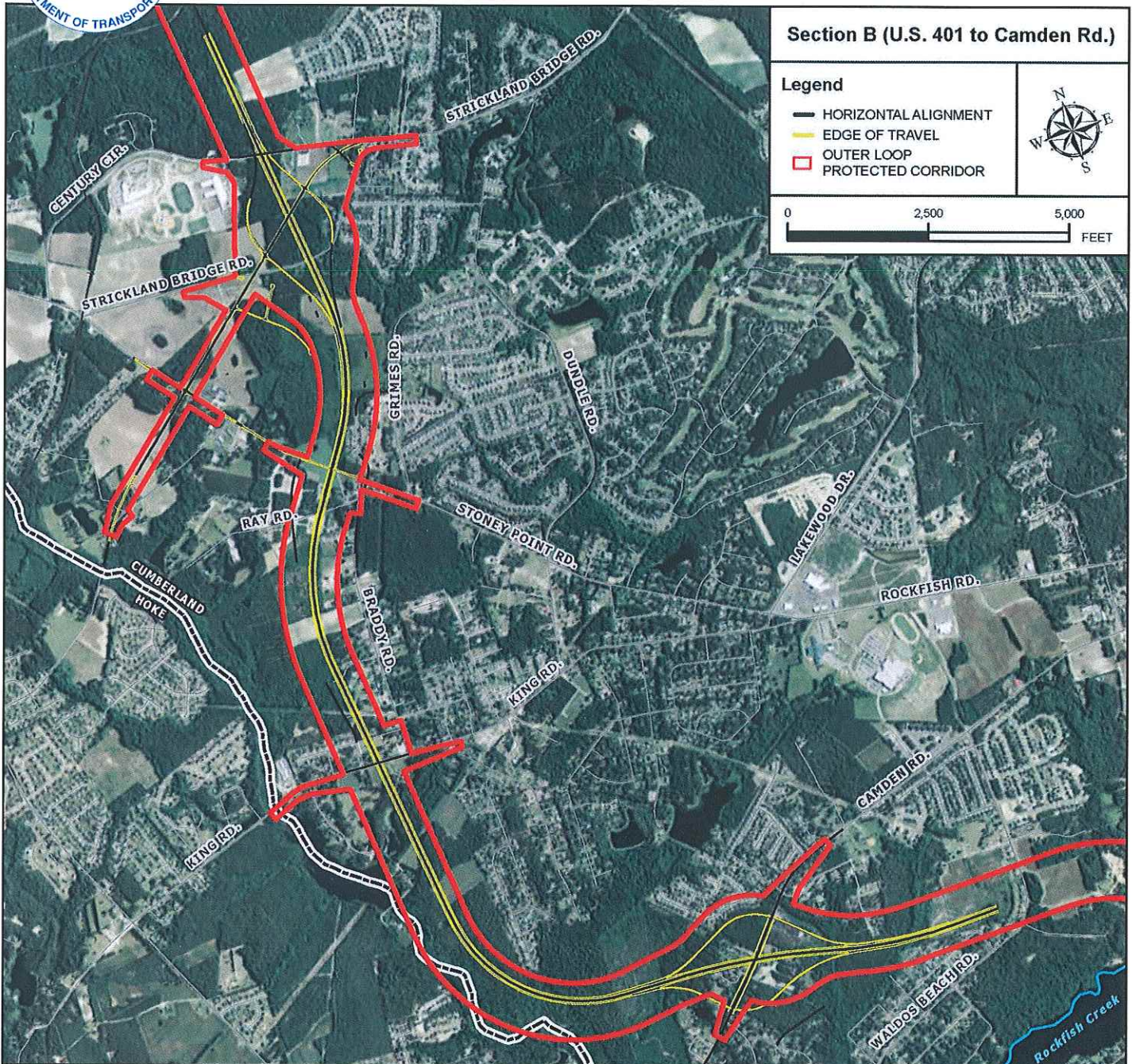
## Section B (U.S. 401 to Camden Rd.)
